DEFINITION:

A Class "B" Special license entitles the holder thereof to sell, barter, or give away retail beer and/or wine, at a specific picnic, festival or similar event. It does not permit the sale or service of liquor. Laws which prohibit the sale of beer or wine to persons who have not attained the age of 21 are applicable.

LICENSE PERIOD: Duration of event.

FEE: \$10

APPLICATION:

Submit application, form ccl-241a, to City Clerk License Division, City Hall, 200 E. Wells Street, Room 105, Milwaukee, WI 53202.

The license shall be applied for by an officer or manager who shall be personally responsible for compliance with all rules and regulations established in ch. 90, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, ch. 125, Wis. Stats. The officer or manager must be of good moral character and have attained the age of 21 years (or have a Class 'D' Operator's license) at the time of filing an application.

Note: Applicants are required to submit applications to the City Clerk License Division no later than 45 days before the event for which the license is sought is to be held.

APPEAL WAIVER:

A Class "B" Special license may be issued to an applicant who files his or her application fewer than 45 days before the event for which the permit is sought provided the applicant waives his or her right to an appeal of any decision made by the Licenses Committee. Complete a Class "B" Special license appeal waiver, form ccl-241b, to file an application fewer than 45 days before the event.

SIGNATURES:

Regardless of whether an officer or manager files the application, signatures of the president and secretary of the organization are required on the application form.

ALTERNATIVE DATES:

Applicants may at the time of application specify on the application alternative dates for which the license is sought in the event of inclement weather. Whenever a license holder wishes to invoke the alternative dates specified on the application, the license holder shall submit to the License Division the Class "B" Special license issued for the original dates and a sworn written statement that no event was operated on the dates specified on the license. A new Class "B" Special license will be issued.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. License may not be issued to individuals.
2. License may only be issued to legally incorporated, non profit organizations; bona fide clubs; organized labor unions; state, county or local fair associations or agricultural societies that have been in existence for not less than six months prior to the date of application; or posts established by veterans' associations.
3. Licenses to organizations, other than ex-servicemen's organizations, can only be issued for picnics or similar gatherings, and not for business or social meetings of the organization.
4. Licenses for business or social meetings of the organization may be issued to ex-servicemen's posts.
5. No more than 2 licenses shall be issued in any 12-month period to the same entity.
6. Organizations that have not obtained this license previously must present proof of their eligibility, i.e. proof of incorporation as a non-profit organization.
7. This license will not be issued to any premises already licensed for alcoholic beverages.
8. The location for which the applicant applies must be owned by or under the control of the applicant.

9. If the event will be held at a Milwaukee County park, Miller Park or on Summerfest grounds, a letter of authorization from the park commission or entity controlling the property must accompany the application.

10. No person other than the licensee shall draw from the original container unless he/she holds a bartender's license or is under the immediate supervision of the licensee or a licensed bartender.

Applications for temporary bartender's licenses are available from the City Clerk License Division.

11. The police department on the date the affair is held makes a check of the premises. A violation of any federal, state or local laws at an event will adversely affect the issuance of any future license to that organization.

12. License may cover either a specified area or the entire picnic grounds; however, license issued to a county or district fair must cover the entire fairground (s. 125.26(6), Wis. Stats.).

13. No license to clubs having any indebtedness to any licensee for more than 15 days for beer (s.125.33 (7)(b), Wis. Stats.), and 30 days for wine (S. 125.69(4)(b), Wis. Stats.).

14. Licensed operator must be present at all times, except on grounds of fairs receiving state aid (ss. 125.26(6), 125.17, and 125.32(2), Wis. Stats.).

16. The licensed club, club members, or any other person are not permitted to possess intoxicating liquor on licensed premises or licensed picnic area (s. 125.32(6), Wis. Stats.).

REFUND OF LICENSE FEE: No refund is available for this license.
