
Dear Mr. Tobin:

Attached please find correspondence for review and approval regarding my proposed changes to the organizational structure of the Milwaukee Police Department. After completing the first year of my tenure, I believe I have a better understanding of the City of Milwaukee and its Police Department.

The modifications, amending the organizational chart dated September 21, 2008, are designed to reflect improved efficiency and reliance on data driven policing strategies. The changes effect the structuring of the Criminal Investigation Bureau with the intent of placing a geographic emphasis on their investigations and thereby increasing their cooperation and communication with District personnel. The other changes, effecting Crime Analysis, Comp Stat, and Planning & Research, will combine my analysis and strategic planning functions into one office. These changes will assist in changing the organizational culture, improve our service to residents and increase safety in neighborhoods and public spaces.

Please consider these changes during your next meeting, scheduled for April 23, 2009. As always, I am available if questions arise.


