
POLICE OFFICER GERALD W. WINDING, (010043), Fifth District, charged with violation of Department Rules and Procedures as follows:



WINDING shall be suspended for thirty (30) working days without pay for the following periods: January 20, 2010 to February 2, 2010. February 7, 2010 to February 20, 2010.
