



Dear Commissioners:

This is to notify your Honorable Board that I have demoted Police Sergeant Roosevelt Jenkins Jr. to the rank of Police Officer, ordered him suspended for a total of thirty-five (35) working days without pay, and discharged him from the Department for violation of the following Department Rules:

Rule 4, Section 010.00: All members of the Department shall familiarize themselves with all the provisions of the Department's Rules and Procedures Manual within 30 days of issuance thereof.

It shall be the duty of all members of the Department to thoroughly familiarize themselves with such provisions of the Department's Rules and Procedures Manual as deal specifically and generally with the duties of their rank, grade, or position within 20 days from assuming that rank, grade or position.

Police recruit officers shall familiarize themselves with all the provisions of the Department's Rules and Procedure Manual prior to graduation.

Failure on the part of members of the Department to acquaint themselves with and abide by the provisions of the Department's Rules and Procedures Manual as hereby directed shall be considered neglect of duty and shall subject such members to disciplinary action.

Rule 5, 500.55: Absence from duty without leave of any member of the Department shall be followed by forfeiture of pay for time absent, and charges shall also be preferred against the members by the district commander or head of the bureau, unless otherwise directed by the Chief of Police. An unexplained absence without leave of any member of the Department for three days shall be considered grounds for discharge.

Page Two

Rule 4, Section 105.00: No member shall intentionally or with reckless disregard for the truth make an untrue statement, either orally or in writing, in connection with any investigation, assignment, or inquiry. Members found to be in violation of this rule shall be subject to discipline up to and including discharge from the Department.

PERSONNEL ORDER 2010 – 33

RE: DISCIPLINARY ACTION

POLICE SERGEANT ROOSEVELT JENKINS, JR., (009234), Technical Communications Division, charged with violation of Department Rules and Procedures as follows:

Rule 4, Section 010.00 referencing Standard Operating Procedures relating to the Communications Division Handbook – Staffing Supervisors, Section 2.19.25: Failure to attempt to locate another supervisor, nor notify the shift or division commanders about being absent from the Technical Communications Division.

Rule 4, Section 010.00 referencing Standard Operating Procedures relating to Computer Equipment – Computer Guidelines, Section 680.05(A): Instructed a subordinate to utilize a Time System terminal to run license plate numbers for a personal, non-Departmental purpose.

Rule 5, Section 500.55: Absent from duty without leave.

Rule 4, Section 105.00: Untruthfulness.

The charges having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:

Failure to attempt to locate another supervisor or notify the shift or division commanders about being absent from the Technical Communications Division.

Demotion to the rank of Police Officer.

Instructed a subordinate to utilize a Time System terminal to run license plate numbers for a personal, non-Departmental purpose.

Five (5) day suspension without pay.


Absent from duty without leave.

Thirty (30) day suspension
without pay.

Untruthfulness.

Discharged from the Department.

It is hereby ordered that POLICE SERGEANT ROOSEVELT JENKINS, JR. be demoted to the rank of Police Officer and be suspended for a total of thirty-five (35) workings days without pay. It is also ordered that POLICE SERGEANT ROOSEVELT JENKINS, JR. be discharged from the Department and removed from the payroll effective immediately pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 62.50(18).
