
This is to notify your Honorable Board that I have discharged Office Assistant III Christine A. Gromacki from the Department for violation of the following Department Rules:

Rule 4, Section 130.00: Members of the Department shall treat as confidential the official business of the Department. They shall not impart it to anyone except those for whom it is intended, or as directed by their commanding officer, or under due process of law; and they shall not make known to any person, whether or not a member of the Department, any special order which they may receive, unless required by the nature of the order.

Rule 4, Section 155.00: Members of the Department shall not communicate verbally or in writing, directly or indirectly, in any manner or form, any information which may enable persons involved in criminal acts or city ordinance violations to escape arrest or punishment, or which may permit them to dispose of or secrete any money, goods, or other valuables unlawfully obtained.
