Dear Commissioners:

This is to notify your Honorable Board that I have suspended Police Officer Matthew J. Truman for a total of thirty-five (35) working days without pay for violation of the following Department Rules:


RULE 4, SECTION 015.00: Members of the police force shall, at all times within the boundaries of the City, preserve the public peace, prevent crime, detect and arrest violators of the law, and protect life and property.

They shall conform to, abide by and enforce all the criminal laws of the State of Wisconsin and the ordinances of the city of Milwaukee of which the Department must take cognizance and they shall render their services to the City with zeal, courage, discretion, and fidelity. They shall render their services to the City in an efficient manner.


Members shall also observe the laws and ordinances in effect in any other jurisdiction while within such jurisdiction.

RULE 4, SECTION 095.00: Members of the Department are prohibited from being under the influence of an intoxicant both on or off duty. For the purpose of this rule, "under the influence of an intoxicant" means that the person's condition is impaired to such an extent that their capacity for rational action or conduct is substantially lessened because of the consumption of an alcoholic beverage. Such persons shall immediately be suspended and charges preferred against them.


POLICE OFFICER MATTHEW J. TRUMAN, (015511), Seventh District, charged with violation of Department Rules and Procedures as follows:

TRUMAN shall be suspended for thirty-five (35) working days without pay for the following periods: May 6, 2010 through May 22, 2010. June 7, 2010 through June 30, 2010. July 5, 2010 through July 8, 2010. POLICE OFFICER MATTHEW J. TRUMAN shall return to duty on July 9, 2010.



Dear Commissioners:

This is to notify your Honorable Board that I have suspended Police Officer Jose M. Luna for a total of forty (40) working days without pay for violation of the following Department Rules:

RULE 4, SECTION 010.00: All members of the Department shall familiarize themselves with all the provisions of the Department's Rules and Procedures Manual within 30 days of the issuance thereof.

It shall be the duty of all members of the Department to thoroughly familiarize themselves with such provisions of the Department's Rules and Procedures Manual as deal specifically and generally with the duties of their rank, grade, or position, within 20 days from the date of assuming that rank, grade or position.

Police recruit officers shall familiarize themselves with all the provisions of the Department's Rules and Procedures Manual prior to graduation.

Failure on the part of members of the Department to acquaint themselves with and abide by the provisions of the Department's Rules and Procedures Manual as hereby directed shall be considered neglect of duty and shall subject such members to disciplinary action.

RULE 4, SECTION 015.00: Members of the police force shall, at all times within the boundaries of the City, preserve the public peace, prevent crime, detect and arrest violators of the law, and protect life and property.

They shall conform to, abide by and enforce all the criminal laws of the State of Wisconsin and the ordinances of the city of Milwaukee of which the Department must take cognizance and they shall render their services to the City with zeal, courage, discretion, and fidelity. 

POLICE OFFICER JOSE M. LUNA, (008188), Property Control Section, charged with violation of Department Rules and Procedures as follows:

Rule 4, Section 010.00, referencing Standard Operating Procedures relating to Leaving Residence While on Sick Leave, Section 010.50: Failure to obtain permission from his commanding officer or his designee prior to leaving his residence or place of confinement while on sick leave.

Rule 4, Section 015.00: Failure to conform to and abide by the criminal laws of the State of Wisconsin.

Rule 4, Section 095.00: Intoxication.

The charges having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:

Failure to obtain permission from his commanding officer or his designee prior to leaving his residence or place of confinement while on sick leave. Five (5) day suspension without pay.

Failure to abide by the criminal laws in effect in the State of Wisconsin. Thirty (30) day suspension without pay.

Intoxication. Five (5) day suspension without pay.

It is hereby ordered that POLICE OFFICER JOSE M. LUNA be suspended for a total of forty (40) working days without pay. If not appealed, POLICE OFFICER JOSE M. LUNA shall be suspended without pay for the following periods: May 5, 2010 through June 4, 2010; from June 9, 2010 through July 1, 2010.
