Dear Commissioners:

This correspondence is to inform you that pursuant to City Ordinance I have approved an extension to the educational leave of absence without pay for Police Officer Nicole Vele. A copy of Officer Vele's request for an extension to her educational leave of absence is attached for reference, along with the correspondence I sent her informing her that I have approved her request, subject to various terms and conditions. Her leave of absence will commence August 24, 2010, and expire August 24, 2011. The purpose of Officer Vele's leave (as stated in her request) is to pursue a law degree.

Requests for unpaid educational leaves of absence are evaluated on a case-by-case basis. They are not to be construed as being precedential in any respect.
