



Dear Commissioners:

This is to notify your Honorable Board that I have ordered that Police Officer Michael Loechler be suspended for thirty (30) working days for violation of the following Department Rule:


RULE 4, SECTION 015.00: Members of the police force shall, at all times within the boundaries of the City, preserve the public peace, prevent crime, detect and arrest violators of the law, and protect life and property.

They shall conform to, abide by and enforce all the criminal laws of the State of Wisconsin and the ordinances of the City of Milwaukee of which the Department must take cognizance and they shall render their services to the City with zeal, courage, discretion, and fidelity. They shall render their services to the City in an efficient manner.

Members shall also observe the laws and ordinances in effect in any other jurisdiction while within such jurisdiction.

If not appealed, POLICE OFFICER MICHAEL LOECHLER shall be suspended for thirty (30) working days without pay for the following periods: October 24, 2010 through October 31, 2010; November 4, 2010 through November 23, 2010; November 29, 2010; November 30, 2010; and December 7, 2010 through December 19, 2010. POLICE OFFICER MICHAEL LOECHLER shall return to duty on December 20, 2010.
