



Dear Commissioners:

This is to notify your Honorable Board that I have ordered that Police Officer Roman A. Martinez be suspended for ten (10) working days for violation of the following Department Rules:

Rule 4, Section 115.00: When members of the police force are called to, or happen upon, the scene of a crime, they shall at once investigate and note all particulars and obtain the names and addresses of witnesses and all other important details; and they shall as soon as practicable communicate the facts obtained to the commanding officer, or designee, of the district in which the crime occurred; except, members of the Criminal Investigation Bureau or Special Operations Bureau, who shall communicate such facts directly to the officer in charge of said bureau. Investigating members shall make a written report as soon as practicable to their commanding officers. Members of the police force making such investigation shall deliver at the scene of the crime all evidence and information obtained in the case to any members of the Criminal Investigation Bureau who may be assigned to such case, upon their arrival. Members of the police force shall prevent unauthorized persons from entering upon the scene of a crime.


