



Dear Commissioners:

This is to notify your Honorable Board that I have ordered that Police Officer Jorge L. Madrigal be suspended for thirty (30) working days without pay and discharged him from the Department for violation of the following Department Rule:


Rule 4, Section 015.00 {Four Counts}: Members of the police force shall, at all times within the boundaries of the City, preserve the public peace, prevent crime, detect and arrest violators of the law, and protect life and property.

They shall conform to, abide by and enforce all the criminal laws of the State of Wisconsin and the ordinances of the City of Milwaukee of which the Department must take cognizance and they shall render their services to the City with zeal, courage, discretion, and fidelity. They shall render their services to the City in an efficient manner.

Members shall also observe the laws and ordinances in effect in any other jurisdiction while within such jurisdiction.

PERSONNEL ORDER 2011 - 14

RE: DISCIPLINARY ACTION

POLICE OFFICER JORGE L. MADRIGAL, (017467), Second District, charged with violation of Department Rules and Procedures as follows:

Rule 4, Section 015.00 (Count One): Failure to conform to and abide by the criminal laws in effect in the State of Wisconsin.

Rule 4, Section 015.00 (Count Two): Failure to conform to and abide by the criminal laws in effect in the State of Wisconsin.

Rule 4, Section 015.00 (Count Four): Failure to conform to and abide by the criminal laws in effect in the State of Wisconsin.

The charges having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:

Discharged from the Department.


Failure to conform to and abide by the criminal laws in effect in the State of Wisconsin (Count Three).

Thirty (30) day suspension without pay.

It is hereby ordered that POLICE OFFICER JORGE L. MADRIGAL be discharged from the Department and removed from the payroll effective immediately pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 62.50(18).
