

RE: DISCIPLINARY ACTION

POLICE OFFICER JAMES M. MORSOVILLO, (012424), Third District, charged with violation of Department Rules and Procedures as follows:

Rule 4, Section 010.00 referencing Standard Operating Procedures relating to Communications – Supervisors Required at Specific Incidents, Section 250.30(5); Core Value 1.00 – Competence, referencing Guiding Principle 1.05: Failure to notify a supervisor of an off-duty incident.

Rule 4, Section 105.00; Core Value 3.00 - Integrity, referencing Guiding Principle 3.10: Untruthfulness.

The charges having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:

Failure to notify a supervisor of an off-duty incident.

Thirty (30) day suspension without pay.

Untruthfulness.

Discharged from the Department.

It is hereby ordered that POLICE OFFICER JAMES M. MORSOVILLO be discharged from the Department and removed from the payroll effective immediately pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 62.50(18).
