PERSONNEL ORDER 2011 - 91

RE: DISCIPLINARY ACTION

POLICE OFFICER MICHAEL N. LOECHLER, (009248), Sixth District, charged with violation of Department Rules and Procedures as follows:

Rule 4, Section 015.00; Core Value 3.00 - Integrity, referencing Guiding Principle 3.05: Failure to conform to and abide by the laws and ordinances in effect in another jurisdiction while within such jurisdiction. (Count One)

Rule 4, Section 015.00; Core Value 3.00 - Integrity, referencing Guiding Principle 3.05: Failure to conform to and abide by the laws and ordinances in effect in another jurisdiction while within such jurisdiction. (Count Two)

The charges having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:

Failure to conform to and abide by the laws and ordinances in effect in another jurisdiction while within such jurisdiction (Count One).

Thirty (30) day suspension without pay.

Failure to conform to and abide by the laws and ordinances in effect in another jurisdiction while within such jurisdiction (Count Two).

Thirty (30) day suspension without pay.

It is hereby ordered that POLICE OFFICER MICHAEL N. LOECHLER be suspended for a total of sixty (60) working days without pay for the following periods: September 12, 2011 through September 25, 2011; October 9, 2011 through October 22, 2011; November 6, 2011 through November 19, 2011; December 3, 2011 through December 16, 2011; January 15, 2012 through January 28, 2012; and February 12, 2012 through February 25, 2012. It is also hereby ordered that any subsequent alcohol-related misconduct on the part of POLICE OFFICER MICHAEL N. LOECHLER shall result in his discharge from the Department.
