RE: DISCIPLINARY ACTION

POLICE OFFICER ERIC D. WURTH, (018034), Third District, charged with violation of Department Rules and Procedures as follows:

Core Value 1.00 – Competence, referencing Guiding Principle 1.05, referencing Standard Operating Procedures relating to Computer Equipment, Applications and Systems, Section 680.05(A): Use of Department computer equipment for personal use.

Core Value 3.00 - Integrity, referencing Guiding Principle 3.02: Failure to avoid regular association with a person known to be engaged in criminal behavior.

Core Value 3.00 - Integrity, referencing Guiding Principle 3.05: Failure to obey the laws in effect in the State of Wisconsin.

The charges having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:

Use of Department computer equipment for personal use.	Thirty (30) day suspension without pay.
Failure to avoid regular association with a person known to be engaged in criminal behavior.	Discharged from the Department.
Failure to obey the laws in effect in the State of Wisconsin.	Discharged from the Department.

It is hereby ordered that POLICE OFFICER ERIC D. WURTH be discharged from the Department and removed from the payroll effective immediately pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 62.50(18).
