





RE: REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF POLICE TELECOMMUNICATOR PROBATION PERIOD (POLICE TELECOMMUNICATOR ROSE M. EWALD)

Dear Commissioners:

The Department respectfully requests that your Honorable Commission extend Police Telecommunicator Rose M. Ewald's probationary period for 66 consecutive days based on the reasons outlined below.

Ms. Ewald was appointed to the Department on June 24, 2013, as a Police Telecommunicator (Regular) beginning a 12-month probationary period and was assigned to the Technical Communications Division. Police Telecommunicator Ewald began a Maternity Leave of Absence on October 9, 2013 and was out 56 days. In addition, Ms. Ewald was on sick leave 10 days during her probationary period. If this extension request is approved, her probationary period will end on August 29, 2014

Ms. Ewald is currently serving a 12-month probationary period that is scheduled to expire on June 24, 2014. Extending her probationary period for 66 days will afford Department supervisors the ability to properly evaluate her performance on the same basis as other probationary Police Telecommunicators. I feel this extension request is reasonable in both purpose and duration for the aforementioned reasons. I therefore respectfully request that your Honorable Commission approve this extension.

Police Telecommunicator Ewald has been informed that the Fire and Police Commission may hear the matter of her probation period extension as its next regular meeting of June 5, 2014. She has been further informed that she may attend this meeting, but her attendance is no required.

Dear Commissioners:

The Department respectfully requests that your Honorable Commission extend Police Telecommunicator Claire T. Zellner's probationary period of 74 days based on the reasons outlined below.

Police Telecommunicator was appointed to the Department on June 24, 2013, as a Police Telecommunicator (Regular) beginning a 12-month probationary period and she is assigned to the Technical Communication Division. She used 4 days of sick time, which began on December 17, 2013. On January 17, 2014, she was out 70 days on a Medical Leave of Absence. If this extension request is approved, her probationary period will end of September 08, 2014.

Police Telecommunicator Zellner is currently serving a 12-month probationary period that is scheduled to expire on June 24, 2014. Extending Police Telecommunicator Zellner's probationary period for 74 days will afford Department supervisors the ability to properly evaluate her performance on the same basis as other probationary police telecommunicators. I feel this extension request is reasonable in both purpose and duration for the aforementioned reasons. I therefore respectfully request that your Honorable Commission approve this extension.
