RE: TERMINATION OF PROBATIONARY POLICE TELECOMMUNICATOR TANISHA R. CALDWELL


Dear Commissioners:

This is to notify your Honorable Commission that I have terminated Police Telecommunicator Tanisha Caldwell effective July 21, 2014. A copy of Personnel Order 2014-75 concerning such termination is attached. By the Department's Code of Conduct, Core Value 1.00 – Competence; Guiding Principle 1.01 probationary members have no appeal rights in the event of discharge.

Former Police Telecommunicator Tanisha R. Caldwell was appointed to the Department on July 7, 2014, and was assigned to the Technical Communications Division. Ms. Caldwell's termination is based on her inability to work sunset Friday through sunset Saturday. The Technical Communications Division operates on a 24/7 basis and she may be assigned to any shift and work on a rotating schedule, which means that some weekend and holiday work is required.

Based on Ms. Caldwell's inability to work the required schedule of the Police Telecommunicator position, her employment with the City of Milwaukee Police Department has been terminated.
