
Dear Commissioners:


Core Value 3.00 – Integrity, referencing Guiding Principle 3.05 (Two Counts)

**PERSONNEL ORDER 2015 – 55**

RE: **DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

POLICE OFFICER CHRISTOPHER T. MOORE, (019779), Fifth District, charged with violation of department Core Values as follows:

Core Value 3.00 - Integrity, referencing Guiding Principle 3.05: Failure to obey the laws of the State of Wisconsin (Count One).

Core Value 3.00 - Integrity, referencing Guiding Principle 3.05: Failure to obey the laws of the State of Wisconsin (Count Two).

The charges having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:

Failure to obey the laws of the State of Wisconsin (Count One).

Thirty (30) day suspension without pay.

Failure to obey the laws of the State of Wisconsin (Count Two).

Fifteen (15) day suspension without pay.

It is hereby ordered that POLICE OFFICER CHRISTOPHER T. MOORE be suspended without pay for a total of forty-five (45) working days. If not appealed, said suspension shall be served during the following periods: July 12, 2015 through July 25, 2015; August 9, 2015 through August 22, 2015; September 6, 2015 through September 19, 2015; October 2, 2015 through October 15, 2015; and November 1, 2015 through November 7, 2015.
