
Core Value 1.00 – Competence, referencing Guiding Principle 1.04

DETECTIVE AMY M. STOLOWSKI, (016279), Sensitive Crimes Division, charged with violation of department Code of Conduct as follows:


Core Value 1.00 - Competence, referencing Guiding Principle 1.04: Failure to properly and thoroughly investigate an incident.
