Dear Commissioners:

With the twenty-eight (28) recommended Police Officer appointments for the Monday, August 15, 2016, recruit class (submitted under separate cover), and the anticipated appointment of seventeen (17) Police Aides to Police Officer effective August 14, 2016, the recruit class would be a total of forty-five (45), if there are no withdrawals on or prior to that date. If our past experience is an indication, the actual size of this class may be smaller as we may lose some individuals for various reasons by the time the class starts.

Accordingly, in addition to the forty-five (45) appointments referenced above, I hereby nominate and appoint on a contingency basis, subject to your approval, the following individuals to the rank of Police Officer effective Monday, August 15, 2016:



These appointments are contingent upon successful completion of a pre-employment medical examination, drug screening, psychological evaluation, background update, and the number of regularly appointed Probationary Police Officers reporting for duty on Monday, August 15, 2016.

The recommended contingency appointment of these individuals shall become effective no earlier than Monday, August 15, 2016, and no later than August 29, 2016. Because it will be difficult to provide reasonable advance notice to these individuals subject to a contingency appointment, actual appointments will be predicated on their availability for work and may necessarily be out of eligibility list rank order. The individuals listed above for contingency appointment will retain their rank on the Police Officer eligible list for appointment consideration to the next occurring recruit Police Officer class if he or she does not become a part of the August 15, 2016, class, unless the list expires or is rescinded.
