**PERSONNEL ORDER 2016-131**

October 13, 2016

**RE: SUPPLEMENTATION OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

DETECTIVE RODOLFO GOMEZ, JR., (015295), Metropolitan Investigations Division, was discharged from the Milwaukee Police Department pursuant to Personnel Order 2013-108 dated December 3, 2013.

DETECTIVE RODOLFO GOMEZ, JR., appealed his discharge to the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners for the City of Milwaukee (FPC), which sustained the charges and affirmed the discharge of DETECTIVE RODOLFO GOMEZ, JR. in a decision dated August 11, 2015. In a decision dated September 15, 2016, a Milwaukee County Circuit Court judge remanded the disciplinary matter to the FPC for a new hearing. The FPC intends to appeal that decision.

DETECTIVE RODOLFO GOMEZ, JR., in a Plea Agreement dated June 2, 2016, acknowledged and agreed that, in connection with the matter for which he was discharged, acting under the color of law as a police officer for the City of Milwaukee, he willfully subjected a person to the deprivation of their rights secured and protected by the Constitution and laws of the United States, including the right to be secure in one's person against unreasonable seizures, which includes the right to be free from the use of unreasonable force by one acting under the color of law.

Having been convicted in the United States District Court, Eastern District of Wisconsin of a violation of Title 18 U.S.C. sec. 242, DETECTIVE RODOLFO GOMEZ, JR is disqualified from his public office in the Department by operation of law, to wit: Article XIII, Section 3(2) of the Wisconsin Constitution and Wisconsin Administrative Code, LES, Section 2.01(1) (c).

As a result of the agreements and admissions in the June 2, 2016 Plea Agreement that he executed, DETECTIVE RODOLFO GOMEZ, JR. is not eligible for employment with the Department, retroactive to June 2, 2016; This Personnel Order shall supplement PERSONNEL ORDER 2013-108, and shall take effect immediately.
