Fence will be painted or stained upon completion. Please note that research has shown that when new, bare wood is exposed to the elements for a period of only a week, the life of the paint job applied to it is likely to be decreased.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
