In accordance with the provisions of Section 308-81(9) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

**The art assembly shall consist of a 12' tall by 7' wide marble statue which was salvaged from other parts of the Basilica. The sculpture will be installed at the former entrance to the historic rectory that had been blocked up years ago. The assembly will be lit by ground spotlights on site. Work shall be completed per submitted and attached photos and drawings.**

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. **Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins.** Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. NORTH UPPER MAIN




EAST UPPER








