
In accordance with the provisions of Section 308-81(9) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

Owner may build one of the following of their choice: a treillage style fence, dog ear vertical board, French gothic vertical board or Sunburst vertical board type fence or the vertical board fence in the lower right corner of page 89 in Living With History. Fence must be painted or stained upon completion. Please note that research has shown that when new, bare wood is left exposed to the elements for a period of only a week, the life of the paint job applied to it is likely to be decreased.

Fence will not extend into the front yard. All work will be done according to drawings in living with history (attached)

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
