Fence shall consist of 2-1/2" posts with 3/4"x3/4" pickets spaced 4" apart. Work shall be consistent with submitted drawings and specifications. The fence shall conform to all applicable Milwaukee building codes for fences.


All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 
