MILWAUKEE POLICE PUTTING GANGS ON NOTICE

Ridding the crime, fear and disorder created by gang activity on the city's streets is a priority of the Milwaukee Police Department's anti gang efforts.

"We will continue to target those who perpetrate fear in our communities and we will ensure that Milwaukee residents have safe public spaces to live, work and play," said Milwaukee Police Chief Edward A. Flynn.

In addition to the Department's Gang Crimes Unit, the Anti-Gang Unit officers assigned to the individual Police Districts are working side by side with Assistant City Attorneys, Assistant District Attorneys and Department of Corrections agents. Those partnerships are enhanced with cooperation from the community-based organizations and elected officials.

The information provided below is a brief synopsis of the gangs that the Intelligence Division - Gang Crimes Unit, along with the district Anti-Gang Units, have disrupted or dismantled in recent years. It should be noted that this list may not be all-inclusive and that many individual gang members who are not members of the gangs listed below have also been arrested on felony charges ranging from homicide to theft, narcotics dealing to illegal firearms possession.
